	*Oblique	Medial foot rotation, plantar surface 30° - 45° to IR, affected digit only
	*Lateral	Affected Digit Only
Os Calcis	*Lateral	
	*Tangential	CR 40° Cephalad
Foot	*AP	CR 10° Posterior angle entering base of 3rd metatarsal
	*Lateral	Dorsiflex foot to 90° angle with leg
	*Oblique	Medial foot rotation, plantar surface 30° to IR
Ankle	*AP	
	*Mortise Oblique	15° - 20° Medial rotation of ankle joint
	*Lateral	
Tibia / Fibia	*AP	Include both joints

Knee	*AP	
	*Lateral	CR 5° to 7° Cephalad
	Optional View - Sunrise	Three view order default
	Optional View - Tunnel	If requested
Femur	Trauma - Bilat Obliques	
	*AP	Include both joints, internal rotation of leg
Hip	*Lateral	Include both joints
	*AP Hip	Affected hip; Do not perform AP Pelvis unless specified by Radiologist
	*Frog Leg Lateral	Affected hip
Pelvis	Trauma - X-Table Lateral	
	*AP	Internal rotation of legs
Sacroiliac Joints	Trauma	Inlet & Outlet views
	*AP	CR 10° Cephalad
	*Bilateral Obliques	Rotate patient body 25° - 35° from table
