Fingers	*PA	Affected digit only
	*Oblique	Rotate palm 45° towards CR, affected digit only
	*Lateral	Affected digit only
Hand	*PA	
	*Oblique	Rotate hand 45° towards CR
	*Fan Finger Lateral	
Wrist	*PA	
	*Oblique	Rotate wrist 45° laterally
	*Lateral	
	Optional View - Navicular	Ulnar flexion, CR 10° - 15° proximal angle if necessary
Forearm	*AP	Include both joints
	*Lateral	
Elbow	*AP	For pediatric patients AP and LAT only
	*Lateral	
	*Oblique	External oblique
	Radial Head	Optional view
Humerus	*AP	Include both joints
	*Lateral	
	Trauma - Transthoracic Lateral	
Shoulder	*AP (2 views)	Internal and External rotation
	*"Y" View	Rotate patient, midcoronal plane 45° - 60° from IR
	Trauma - Transthoracic	
	Axillary	Optional view
Scapula	*AP	
	*Lateral - "Y"	Rotate patient, midcoronal plane 45° - 60° from IR
Acromioclavicular Joints	*Bi-Lateral (2 views)	Upright with and without weights
Clavicle	*AP	
	*Axial	CR 20° - 25° Cephalad
